



BAHAMAS NATIONAL CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 2011 (CLOSED)

The Bahamas National Chess Championship 2010 is a single round robin tournament with 7 players. The tournament is both Bahamas Chess Federation (BCF) and World Chess Federation (FIDE) rated and runs from Saturday November 5 to Sunday November 20, 2010 on the island of New Providence, The Bahamas.

Time Control: 75/40 then SD 15. This means that each player is given 75 minutes to make 40 moves and then 15 minutes to complete the game.

Venue: All games will be played at C.W. Sawyer Primary School Auditorium.

Tournament Director (TD) –

Additional Regulations - The FIDE Laws of Chess will govern the tournament. The **default time is 15 minutes** after the scheduled start time. If a player defaults two (2) games he will be withdrawn from the tournament. The organizer will supply chess sets and clocks, however, players should bring their own chess set for any post game analysis.

Playing Area – Once players games are completed they are considered a spectator and are required to immediately leave the playing area. This rule applies to players with a bye.

Preponements - Postponements will not be allowed. Any player wishing to prepone a game must first consult with his opponent. If both players agree to the preponement the requesting player must inform the TD at least 48 hours before the start of the next round so that the TD can make the necessary arrangements for the match to be played. The player will also be required to pay a Director's fee of \$20.00 for this special arrangement before the rescheduled.

Cell Phones - All cell phones should be turned off before the start of each round. If a player's cell phone rings or vibrates during a tournament game, the offending player automatically forfeits the game.

Photography - Flash photography shall be permitted only during the first 5 minutes of each round.
